### Presentation:

### Development of New Technologies for Structural Inspection of Existing Bridges

*Speaker: Dr. Suyun Ham*

*Assistant Professor at the University of Texas at Arlington*

The University of Texas at Arlington has received funding from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to use a testing system invented by a UTA researcher to inspect bridges for repairs without disrupting Texas commuters. This grant will go towards using Dr. Ham's non-contact testing system to make faster, easier and more accurate determinations about when and where bridge repairs are needed. Dr. Ham's system uses sensors mounted to a moving platform that can be pulled behind a vehicle. It detects mechanical waves created by an automatic impacting instrument striking the surface of the bridge. The waves can penetrate the bridge surface up to three feet deep and be mapped to a 3D image, similar to an MRI, to show hidden damage. Current methods require workers to drag or tap on the surface and listen for hollow sounds that could indicate potential problems. Because the system is mounted on a trailer and operates on a particular frequency, it is not necessary to close lanes for testing, and it can give engineers better insight into the entire structure, which can be difficult to access.
